- Ageing research – mostly funded by EU – problem of use and dissemination

- Donation – TIMA Foundation, application under auspices of established professional Association NGO Hellenic Association of G&G
- Many individuals and institutions worked on ageing but without easy access to foreign language and Greek findings.

Over 1200 links and Abstracts in Greek have been entered on the site as of January 2018 via 22 part time expert researchers
